Puppy Derby, Hungarian Short Distance Championship, Hungarian Long Distance Championship

FCI-regulated Oval Track Races and MAVE Category Races

Location:	Alsónémedi, Főúti erdő 11., HUNGARY
Competition lead:	István Gálik
Schedule:	Registration: Saturday competitors: Saturday 2–2.30 PM Sunday competitors: Sunday 9.30–10 AM
Distances:	280 m, 370 m, 480 m, 760 m
Lure pulling system:	Automated
Racing track:	Sand with sprinkler system, double-U curves.
Timing:	Video and timing available for every sighthound.
Liability:	Neither the organizer, nor the contributors are not responsible for the injuries or damages of the sighthounds, the owners or the contributors. Also, organizers are not responsible for unleashed sighthounds. Owner is not responsible for injuries caused by his/her sighthound during racing. Otherwise owner is responsible for all injuries and damages caused by or to his/her sighthound.
Prizes:	Each and every sighthound will be rewarded. Each and every sighthound will run in final round.
Category race:	It will take place according to MAVE performance monitoring regulations on Sunday in one run. Category race will be organized for all distances.
Trap distribution:	Category race: according to the competition lead's decision. FCI-ruled races: drawing in semi-finals; in finals in racing jacket order the owner decides.
Entry fee:	FCI: For MAVE/MEOESZ members: first sighthound is 4000 HUF / 13€, second and third sighthounds are for 3000 HUF / 10€, respectively, fourth sighthound (from the same owner) is for free. For non-members the fee is doubled. Category race: For members 4000 HUF or 13€ / sighthound independently from the number of the entered sighthounds. For non-members the fee is doubled. Show run: 2000 HUF / 7€. Licence run: 1000 HUF / 3,50€. Valid membership card and original pedigree are needed to certify authority and ownership. Paying at the site of the competition will result 1000 HUF / 3,50€ extra fee per owner. Pre-payment is possible via bank transfer or via PayPal. By sending the entry form owner takes responsibility that entry fee will be paid in case of withdrawal from competition.

FCI Hungarian Short Distance Championship, 2015

FCI-ruled competition with title. Competition will be organized according to MAVE performance monitoring regulations.

Entry terms: All sighthounds are eligible for entry that has FCI licence, that has minimum age of 14 months (for small breeds this is 12 months) and that does not become 9 years old in 2015.

Day of competition: Sunday

Distances: 280 m for all breeds.

Organizing and prizing: If number of entries is less than 4, show run will take place. If number of entries is 4 or 5, competition will take place, but neither title, nor presentation jacket will be given. If number of entries is 6 or more, presentation jacket and "Rövidtávú Magyar Bajnok 2015" (Hungarian Short Distance Champion 2015) title will be given.

If the number of male and female entries is 6, respectively, genders will run separately, otherwise in mix runs.

Up to 6 entries 1 semi-final and 1 final run will take place. If number of entries is above 6, 2 semi-finals will take place and 6 sighthounds with the best times will get into Final A, next 6 sighthounds with the next best times will get into Final B etc. In case of Greyhounds if the number of entries is above 6, 1 semi-final is obligatory and the second "time-correcting" run is optional. In the optional run there must be at least 3 sighthounds.

FCI Hungarian Long Distance Championship, 2015

FCI-ruled competition with title. Competition will be organized according to MAVE performance monitoring regulations.

Entry terms: All sighthounds are eligible for entry that has FCI licence, that was born between January 2009 and January 2013.

Day of competition: If the number of entries is 6 or less: Sunday only. If number of entries is above 6: 1 semi-final on Saturday and 1 final on Sunday.

Distances: 760 m for large breeds; 480 m for small breeds (whippet and Italian greyhound)

Organizing and prizing: If number of entries is less than 3, show run will take place. If number of entries is 3, 4 or 5, competition will take place, but neither title, nor presentation jacket will be given. If number of entries is 6 or more, presentation jacket and "Hosszútávú Magyar Bajnok 2015" (Hungarian Long Distance Champion 2015) title will be given.

If the number of male and female entries is 6, respectively, genders will run separately, otherwise in mix runs.

Up to 6 entries 1 final run will take place on Sunday.

If number of entries is above 6, 1 semi-finals will take place and 6 sighthounds with the best times will get into Final A, next 6 sighthounds with the next best times will get into Final B etc.



FCI Puppy Derby 2015

FCI-ruled competition with title. Competition will be organized according to MAVE performance monitoring regulations.

Entry terms:

For the entry the following terms must suit:

- the sighthound has FCI registered pedigree,
- the sighthound has licence or can prove clear run (with racer partners) on oval racing track with training book or licence report and
- the sighthound was born after 30th September 2013.

Day of competition:

For Greyhounds and Magyar Agárs: semi-final on Saturday and final on Sunday.
Other breeds: all runs on Sunday.

Distances:

Standard distance for all breeds: 480 m for large breeds and 370 m for small breeds.

Organizing and prizing:

If number of entries is less than 4, show run will take place. If number of entries is 4 or 5, competition will take place, but neither title, nor presentation jacket will be given. If number of entries is 6 or more, presentation jacket and "Kölyök Derby Győztes 2015" (Puppy Derby Winner 2015) title will be given.

Females and males will run in mix irrespectively from the number of entries.

Up to 6 entries 1 semi-final and 1 final run will take place. If number of entries is above 6, 2 semi-finals will take place and 6 sighthounds with the best times will get into Final A, next 6 sighthounds with the next best times will get into Final B etc. In case of Greyhounds if the number of entries is above 6, 1 semi-final is obligatory and the second "time-correcting" run is optional. In the optional run there must be at least 3 sighthounds.
